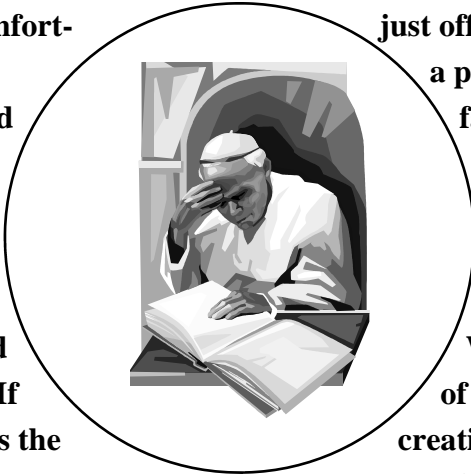


*SUNDAY MORNINGS, 10:00AM starting in January*
